

JENNINGS *GP*

NORTH FLORIDA

Levels of participation:

C Group (Licensed motorcyclists, competent riders whose experience is largely limited to local and highway travel)

B Group (More experienced riders who are comfortable riding mountain roads at a slightly elevated pace)

A Group (Advanced riders who may have attended track days and are interested in honing their high speed skills)

Preparation and Requirements for the Sport Touring School:

Motorcycle

- All lights taped over completely; brake light fuses removed or lens completely covered and opaque.
- Mirrors must be removed or taped (except instructors).
- Tires – must have 75% minimum tread, no flat spots, no plugs or patches. Recommended tire pressures are 30-34 F, 28-32 R (cold).
- Brake pads – 50% minimum pad material.
- Side and center stands NEED NOT be removed, no safety wire is required.
- Absolutely no leaking fluid will be tolerated (oil, water, gas, etc.).
- All bodywork, seats, etc. firmly and appropriately affixed. Detachable bags and top cases removed.
- No excessively loud pipes please (104db maximum).

Personal

- Entrant must be a member in good standing of the BMW Motorcycle Owners of NE Florida as of 9/6/09.
- Full leathers are highly recommended. Armored textile clothing (Aerostich, BMW, or similar suits) are acceptable. Mesh jackets and chaps are not acceptable. The track may have a limited number of leather suits available for rent, Contact the track, at 386-938-1110.
- Leather gloves, gauntlet style (no exposed wrist skin).
- Full-face helmet is required, Snell approved is preferred, flip ups will be accepted but are not recommended. Helmets should be no more that 5 years old, inner foam must not have deteriorated.
- Boots must be over the ankle height. Motorcycle specific boots are recommended, no trainers.

Other

- There may/may not be gas available at the track. Arrive with a full tank. Consider bringing extra gas.
- This is a rain or shine event. It may be hot, cold or wet, be prepared with proper gear.

Directions to Jennings GP:

I-75 FL exit #467, south on CR143, 3 mi. to blinker light, right onto CR152, 1/3 mile to track on right. Gates open at 3:00 PM on Friday for campers and set-up. Feel free to stop in and have a look around. We will walk the track at 5:30 PM on Friday evening.

General

While we will provide limited assistance in preparing motorcycles for operation on the track, it is entirely the rider's responsibility, not that of the club or the track. Track management retains the authority to deny track access to any motorcycle or rider not meeting their safety standards.

The instructor cadre may elect to reclassify riders to keep riding groups balanced. Riders deemed to be riding in an unsafe or overly aggressive manner will be excluded from the event. **This is not a racing school!**

Lodging

Lodging is available at the Days Inn (229-559-0229) at Exit 5 off I-75 in Lake Park, GA. There is also a Hampton Inn at that exit (229 559-5565), and a Cracker Barrel for breakfast.

Food Service

There is a vendor on site at the track. Food was pretty good last year, or bring cold drinks and a light lunch.
